This project will enable students to practice some of the most important woodworking skills used in guitar making, including: measuring, milling, joinery, squaring, sanding, assembly, and finishing.

COURSE OBJECTIVE: To give incoming students the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the R-V shop environment and tool use and maintenance. Especially recommended for students with little or no previous woodworking experience, and for those who wish to brush up on skills.
