HOUSING:

- _____ Make housing arrangements by August 1st or sooner if possible (see Housing Information sent)
- _____ Notify Bart Applewhite if you want to share an apartment. Also notify Bart if you are willing to put up a classmate for a few days (while they're looking for accommodations).

TOOLS:

- _____ Fill out the Tool List form with the tools you would like to purchase from Roberto-Venn. Send this list to us, with payment, by August 22nd. We will assume that you are bringing any of the required tools that are not on the list.

INSTRUMENTS:

- _____ **RECOMMENDED:** Make sketches or drafts of any design ideas you have for instruments. (Including: electric body style, head stock - acoustic and/or electric, fingerboard inlay, and rosette). Please remember that any design ideas must be approved. We will spend time on design and options available during the first two weeks of class.

- _____ **RECOMMENDED:** Bring an acoustic and/or electric guitar that needs set-up, intonation work, fret work, nut & saddle adjustments, or other repair, if you can. Preferably with a rosewood or ebony fretboard as maple is difficult to work with for the novice. Note: this is not mandatory, we will have instruments to work on during the repair section of the course.

TUITION / MATERIALS DEPOSIT

- _____ Bring payment for **\$6,375** on first day of class (one half tuition payment - \$5,375 - plus instrument materials deposit - \$1000*). If you qualify for financial aids you will be notified individually as to what, if any, tuition and materials deposit will be due on the first day of class. Second half tuition is due the eleventh week of instruction (\$5,375). Plus balance (\$800* materials deposit) of instrument costs due third month of class. * sales tax of 8.3% will be added to all material purchases.
Total 2nd half charges: **\$6,175.**
